## BCA's Summer Reading Mission for Jr. & Sr. High ~ Summer 2015

### Your Mission (should you choose to accept it) :

- 1) Read 5 books during the summer (includes 4 books that are listed as your teachers' favorites (1 of these 4 is a picture book), plus 1 book of your choosing. Your packet will include a list of your teachers' favorites by genre.
- 2) Check your Bingo Board to see how you want to choose to make your 5-in-a-row Bingo (horizontally, vertically, or diagonally).
- 3) Check the Teachers' Favorites Lists to find a book you'd like to read for each of the Bingo boxes you've chosen to complete.  
**For example:** If you choose the top row horizontally across, you will look for an autobiography, a fantasy or fairy tale, a picture book, a legend/tall tale/or myth, and one book of your choosing.

- Books of the Bible:** A list of books from the Bible.

- 4) Find the reading log (online-[www.pamfreed.com](http://www.pamfreed.com)) that goes along with the books/genre you've chosen, complete the questions for each of your books (should be 4 books - you do not have to complete a reading log for the student choice book.)
- 5) Staple your completed reading logs to your completed Bingo board and turn in to Mrs. Freed in the BCA media center the first day you return to school in August 2015.

### Where do I get the Bingo Board and Reading Logs?

You may pick up a packet in the BCA Media Center before you leave school for the summer OR you can download and print copies at home from [www.pamfreed.com](http://www.pamfreed.com) ~ all reading logs are available individually for download on our website, they are not a part of your packet because we don't want to print all the genre copies for each packet when you will only need 4 for this mission. ☺
