

Directions for Creating World War II Flash Cards

- 1) Cut your cards in half (you should have 16 cards - 32 when cut).
- 2) On the back side of the card (the lined side), write the definition for each item (#1-31) from your definition sheet.
***Points will be deducted for missing or misspelled words & for messy work.
REMEMBER! DO NOT write the main word you are defining on this side of the card (these are flash cards to study with).

- 3) Cut out picture (& label) #1 (Allies) & glue to the front (the side with no lines) of definition card #1.

After you have finished gluing the first card, THEN, continue - ONE AT A TIME - to cut out remaining pix & glue to definition cards - ONE AT A TIME!

In other words...

Cut each one individually and glue to the matching card before cutting out the next one.

- 4) Keep all your pieces in the Ziploc bag.
